Meet your Municipal Emergency Coordinator (MEC)



Barb Gillis, MEC

I am Barb Gillis the Municipal Emergency Coordinator (MEC) for the RM of Alexander. My job includes maintaining and updating the emergency plan for the municipality, organizing exercises to confirm the plan and practice skills, and during an emergency to run the Emergency Operations Centre (EOC) which supports the first responders.

The RM is wonderful but challenging with a vast land mass, lots of lakes, rivers and woods. Residents are in towns, small villages, and in cottage and rural areas. There are both permanent and seasonal residents

which provides different challenges. We hope never to have an emergency but with natural influences including forest fires, blizzards, tornadoes, and of course hazards like dangerous goods, electrical outages, etc. there is always a chance and we want to be prepared to ensure resiliency.

One of the important jobs is ensuring that all of our residents know what to do in an emergency. To facilitate this, I will be putting facts, links and reminders on the RM of Alexander Facebook page. We will be adding to

the RM Webpage and hopefully we will connect in other ways on an annual basis.

I am looking for volunteers to help in a variety of positions both in the Emergency Operations Centre and with the Emergency Social Services group which helps support those that may have to be evacuated. There is a small amount of training required and then participation once or twice a year in a practice event. A volunteer registration form is available at the office and from the webpage. Storm Update

As a result of the storm many areas of the municipality experienced power outages mainly in the Beaches area. Manitoba Hydro crews continue to work to restore power. The Great Falls Water Treatment plant and sewer system were without power and not running for approximately 24 hours. As a result, a boil water advisory remains in effect until further notice. If things go well the lines can be flushed and sampling protocol over

two days will be sufficient to ask the province to remove the order.

The roads were in rough shape because of all of the snow. RM of Alexander crews are out over the weekend clearing main and secondary roads. When things melt residents will no doubt see many tons of gravel in the ditches as a result of plowing the thick, heavy and very sticky snow from the storm.

The RM has begun a

major tree clearing operation. Additional resources will be brought in to help remove trees and tree limbs that are dangerous or could impact roads and drainage systems. Crews will be out noting these situations so the RM will be aware of most of the problem areas, however, please feel free to report any tree issues to the RM office by email info@rmalexander.com or call 204-367-6170.
